

SWKIDS Service Questions

(Good Friday)

1. Why did Jesus need to die on the cross for us? *Read Romans 3:23.*
2. *Read Romans 5:6-8.* Explain to someone near you what sin is. (Sin is anything bad that we do, that we say, or that we think about, that goes against God.) But these verses tell us that even while we were *sinners*, Jesus still died on the cross and took the punishment we deserve!
3. After Jesus died, the curtain inside the temple was torn in two (*Mark 15:38*). In the Old Testament, only the high priest was able to enter the Most Holy Place in the tabernacle (similar to the temple). The Most Holy Place was separated by a curtain from the Holy Place. The high priest had to sacrifice an animal for his sins and the sins of the people. But Jesus died *once* for all people and if anyone accepts God's gift of salvation, they will be saved. So what does it mean that the curtain in the temple was torn?
4. On Sunday, we will talk more about Jesus coming back to life (that's called the resurrection). But to help us start preparing for Easter, why is it so important that Jesus came back from the dead? *Read Romans 6:9-11.*
