(Easter Sunday)

1. Think about the days after Jesus died on the cross and before Jesus came back to life. How do you think Jesus' followers would have felt?
2. How did Mary and the disciples react when they found out Jesus was alive?
3. On Friday, you talked a little bit about why the resurrection is so important. As you celebrate today, think about that again. Romans 6:9-11 says that Jesus cannot die again; he defeated sin and death! How does this change the way we live? As a follower of Jesus, do we have to be afraid of anything knowing this truth?
4. Why do you think Jesus asked Peter "do you love Me" three times? Do you think it has anything to do with Peter's denial of Jesus?
5. What are ways we can respond to Jesus' resurrection? Pray and thank God for sending Jesus to die and come back to life for us. Thank God for saving us from our sin and for defeating sin and death! Then, think of someone you want to share this Good News with!
