1. How did Hosea respond to God's command to marry someone who would not love him back?
2. Think about Israel's relationship with God. How was Hosea's relationship with his wife similar? Think about the way Gomer treated Hosea and how Israel treated God and think about how Hosea responded to Gomer and how God responded to Israel.
3. Our craft for this week is a picture of a sunrise. Read through Hosea 6:3, our MVP: "Let us know; let us press on to know the Lord; His going out is sure as the dawn; He will come to us as the showers, as the spring rains that water the earth." Just like we know the sun will rise (another word for sunrise is "dawn"), we know God will be faithful to us. What can we do to be faithful to God?
4. What should we do when we are tempted to love someone or something else more than God?
5. Take time now to practice Hosea 6:3 and thank God for His faithfulness to us!
