## SWKIDS Service Questions (3.14.21)

## Read Jeremiah 31:33-34.

- 1. What did Jeremiah say would be different about God's new covenant with His people? In the old covenant, the people had God's commands in writing. They disobeyed His commands and made sacrifices every year for their sin. In the new covenant, God was going to write His law on their hearts. He would give His people the power to obey His commands. (Option: read Hebrews 10:16.)
- 2. How does God change our hearts today? Jesus came to establish the new covenant. We all sin and, just like the people of Judah, need a heart change. God invites us into a relationship with Him through Jesus and then He gives us power through the Holy Spirit to obey God's commands when we decide to follow Him. (Option: read Ezekiel 11:19-20.)
- 3. Why should we obey God? We should obey God because He made us, He loves us, and His plans are good. We don't have to earn His love. We already have it! (Option: read Ephesians 2:8-10.)
- 4. Take time now to practice the MVP for this week: Jeremiah 31:33 (ESV) which says, "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people." We can thank God every day for His gift of salvation through His Son Jesus!
